**A REGULAR MEETING OF THE DEWEY-HUMBOLDT OSAT COMMITTEE WAS HELD ON WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 3, 2011, AT TOWN HALL AT 2735 S. HIGHWAY 69, DEWEY-HUMBOLDT, ARIZONA. CHAIR SANDRA GOODWIN PRESIDED.**

1. **CALL TO ORDER.** The meeting was called to order at 3:00 p.m.
2. **PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE.** Made
3. **ROLL CALL.** Executive Members Skip Gladue, Carol Barker, Jason Allen, Vice Chair Kevin Leonard, Chair Sandra Goodwin, and Associate Member Norm Perry were present.

**4. CONSENT AGENDA.**

4.1. Minutes. Minutes from the June 29th and July 13th meetings. Minutes from the June 29<sup>th</sup> and July 13<sup>th</sup> meetings were accepted as approved by Chair Goodwin.

**5. REGULAR AGENDA - Unfinished Business -**

5.1. Butte Street Park. Chair Goodwin shared photos of a park in Prescott Valley illustrating benches, pagodas, trees, etc. and discussed the cost of the park in Prescott Valley's 50' ROW. There was discussion on liability with donated equipment; and the possibility of a community clean-up day. Butte Street Park and Corley Street Trailhead discussion will be on the Agenda for the August 9, 2011 Town Council Work Session at 2 p.m. There was discussion on speaking to the community; exploring options and associated costs; the possibility that the community may come forth to help.

Butte Street Park development will be discussed on the next agenda.

5.2. Corley Street Trail/Trail Head. There will be an exploratory ride through the gate to Spud Mountain on Monday, August 8, 2011 at 9 a.m. The group will leave from E. Corley Street. There was a reminder to be aware of the Open Meeting Law; discussion on exploring possible hiking and equestrian trails; the BLM map not identifying undeveloped ROW; and speaking to Carol Wagner since she has grazing rights.

**6. REGULAR AGENDA - New Business.** There was discussion on the Chairman of the BLM leaving in September; preparing a plan to present to the new Chairman; and looking at the BLM parcel on Henderson.

**7. COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC.** Mike Nathe spoke on the property behind the Post Office saying it's a good idea for Town to purchase the land as it is a great asset, more revenue and business for the Town.
