

RESOLUTION NO. 05-16

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF DEWEY-HUMBOLDT, ARIZONA, DEFINING THE DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF TOWN COMMITTEES.

WHEREAS, there are many issues and projects that require the efforts of staff, citizens and Council Members to provide an effective resolution to these projects and issues; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Town of Dewey-Humboldt has determined that by involving the public and volunteers with the support of Town Staff in addressing these concerns is cost effective and allows citizens a mechanism to be involved in the Town's programs; and

WHEREAS, the development of the Dewey-Humboldt Town Code will include various provisions for the administration and operation of the Town:


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Town of Dewey-Humboldt hereby creates the following volunteer Committees:

- A. Environmental Issues Advisory Committee that will provide for the identification, assessment and monitoring of environmental/public health issues of concern to the Town.
- B. Clean Town Committee that will provide volunteer services to the Town and its citizens in developing programs that address issues of accumulated trash, code enforcement and related concerns.

Committees can be formed and meet at their own time and place. The Town will assist in the recruitment of volunteers and upon request of a Committee, will consider funding costs of the programs and projects that each Committee may identify.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Town of Dewey-Humboldt will include these provisions in its Town Code to be adopted by Ordinance at a future date.


