

RESOLUTION NO. 05-20

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF DEWEY-HUMBOLDT, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING THE ACQUISITION OF A CREDIT CARD FOR THE TOWN OF DEWEY-HUMBOLDT FROM STOCKMEN'S BANK.

WHEREAS, Resolution 05-03, authorized the establishment of bank accounts at the Stockmen's Bank in Prescott Valley, in order to conduct the business of the Town of Dewey-Humboldt ; and,


WHEREAS, in the course of normal business, the Town of Dewey-Humboldt has found it necessary to make purchases for materials, supplies and services that are difficult without access to a line of credit; and,

WHEREAS, it has become evident, that with a credit card, the Town Administration will be able to conduct certain necessary business of the Town more efficiently; and,


WHEREAS, the use of the card would be used for only items that do not qualify for a Town account, petty cash purchases or similar situations;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town of Dewey-Humboldt Administration take the necessary steps to acquire a credit card from Stockmen's Bank with a credit limit of \$10,000 for the Town of Dewey-Humboldt; said cards will be issued to the Mayor, Town Clerk and Town Manager;


