

RESOLUTION NO. 05-21

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF DEWEY-HUMBOLDT, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING THE TOWN TO JOIN THE YAVAPAI COUNTY WATER ADVISORY COMMITTEE (WAC) AND NOMINATING MAYOR TOM HINTZE AS ITS REPRESENTATIVE.

WHEREAS, the Yavapai County Water Advisory Committee is a Regional Advisory Committee to the Yavapai County Board of Supervisors comprised of elected officials from the various governmental jurisdictions within Yavapai County; and,

WHEREAS, the Town of Dewey-Humboldt is eligible for appointment by the Board of Supervisors as a member of the Committee; and,


WHEREAS, membership on the Committee will provide the opportunity for the Town to participate in the development of sound water management policies and the collection of information; and,

WHEREAS, each jurisdiction pays an annual fee based on population that for the remainder of Fiscal 2006 would equal approximately \$1,700; and,


WHEREAS, the Town has created the Groundwater Resources Advisory Committee with Mayor Tom Hintze as Chairman,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and Town Council request that the Yavapai County Board of Supervisors ratify the Town as a member of the Yavapai County Water Advisory Committee, with Mayor Tom Hintze as the Town's representative.
