

RESOLUTION NO. 06-22

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF DEWEY-HUMBOLDT
SUPPORTING THE CONTINUED CARRIAGE OF THE NBC NETWORK
BY CABLE ONE AT NO ADDITIONAL COST TO THE DEWEY-HUMBOLDT
RESIDENTS SERVED BY CABLE ONE

WHEREAS, the Town of Dewey-Humboldt is a franchise authority for cable television and currently has a franchise agreement with Cable One; and

WHEREAS, the management at Cable One has made the Town aware of the intention of NBC to drop Cable One as a carrier for that network effective January 1, 2006, unless Cable One agrees to pay cash for carriage; and

WHEREAS, the NBC network uses the public airwaves and is available free of charge to residents in the greater Phoenix area; and

WHEREAS, the ability to receive reliable signals for the NBC network in the Dewey-Humboldt, Prescott, Prescott Valley, and Chino Valley areas of central Yavapai County and in the Verde Valley without benefit of cable television is either difficult or non-existent; and

WHEREAS, if Cable One must pay for carriage of the NBC network the cost of carriage will be passed on to Dewey-Humboldt residents who are served by Cable One.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Council of the Town of Dewey-Humboldt supports the continued carriage of the NBC network by Cable One at no additional cost to Dewey-Humboldt residents who are served by Cable One.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Dewey-Humboldt Town Council urges the NBC network to take into consideration in its negotiations with Cable One, the thousands of Yavapai County residents, including the Town of Dewey-Humboldt, who must rely upon cable for dependable television service and who will either have to pay an additional amount for the privilege of viewing network programming that is free to residents in the Phoenix area, or who will be denied access to programs on NBC if Cable One is dropped as a carrier.


