

RESOLUTION NO. 07-36

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF DEWEY-HUMBOLDT, ARIZONA, REPEALING RESOLUTION NO. 07-30, DUTIES OF THE MAYOR.

WHEREAS, the Council of the Town of Dewey-Humboldt desires to further define the duties and responsibilities of the Mayor and the process for developing Council agendas, and,

WHEREAS, the Council of the Town of Dewey-Humboldt passed Resolution No. 07-30 on February 20, 2007, to be effective on March 22, 2007, which defined the duties and responsibilities of the Mayor and amended Resolution Number 05-15;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Town of Dewey-Humboldt repeals Resolution No. 07-30 which defined the duties and responsibilities of the Mayor.

And further, declaring an emergency, this resolution will be effective on March 23, 2007, in order to avoid any ambiguity regarding the duties and responsibilities of the Mayor such that the provisions of Resolution No. 05-15 will be in effect until such time that the Council adopts a resolution reflecting changes to those duties, responsibilities and the development of Council Agendas.
