

RESOLUTION № 08-59

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF DEWEY-HUMBOLDT, ARIZONA, COMMITTING TO SUPPORT THE REDI; ASSERTING POLICY AUTHORITY; AUTHORIZING THE PREPARATION OF DOCUMENTS, AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, the Town is a community representing a total population of less than 50,000, based on the 2000 census, and is geographically located outside the Phoenix and Tucson metropolitan areas;

WHEREAS, the State of Arizona has established the REDI program to provide direct assistance to such communities in effectively managing an economic development program, evaluating community resources; and targeting effective strategies to enhance community attractiveness and investment in sustainable community growth;

WHEREAS, REDI funding is available as matching grants for consulting services, resource document development, marketing activities, and specific studies or projects that have statewide benefit; and

WHEREAS, the Town must be "accredited" to receive these benefits:

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Mayor and Town Council of the Town of Dewey-Humboldt, Arizona that:

Section 1: Commitment to support the Rural Economic Development Initiative.


It shall be the public policy of the Town of Dewey Humboldt to support economic development activities that are consistent with the Town's character as a low-density residential community, and to support for the Rural Economic Development Initiative (REDI).

Section 2: Policy Authority. The Town represents a cross-section of the community with legal authority to raise and administer public funds and to set and/or implement policy must be in place, and hereby guarantees to follow necessary procedures.

Section 3: Authorization to Prepare Documents. The Town Manager, Town Clerk, Town Attorney, and any other necessary persons are hereby authorized to prepare the agreements, forms and instruments contemplated to be used by the Town in achieving REDI accreditation.

Section 4: Effective Date. This Resolution shall be effective immediately.


