

RESOLUTION N^o 10-79

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF DEWEY-HUMBOLDT, COUNTY OF YAVAPAI, ARIZONA, ADOPTING THE DEWEY-HUMBOLDT MULTI-HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Whereas, the Town of Dewey-Humboldt has historically experienced damage from natural hazards such as Drought, Flood/Flash Flood, Thunderstorms and Wildfire during the past century, possibly resulting in loss of property and life, economic hardship and threats to public health and safety; and

Whereas, the Town of Dewey-Humboldt Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan (the "Plan") has been developed by the Town of Dewey-Humboldt in association and cooperation with State of Arizona Division of Emergency Management for the reduction of hazard risk to the community; and

Whereas, the Plan specifically addresses potential hazard mitigation strategies and plan maintenance procedures for the town of Dewey-Humboldt.

Now, Therefore, Be it resolved by the Mayor and Common Council of the Town of Dewey-Humboldt, Arizona:

1. The Dewey-Humboldt Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan shall be adopted as follows:
 - 1.1. The Plan is hereby adopted as an official plan of the Town of Dewey-Humboldt.
 - 1.2. The Plan shall be implemented, monitored, and maintained by the officials and staff designated in the Plan for a period of five (5) years with the support of this resolution.
 - 1.3. Future revisions and Plan maintenance actions required by the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 and FEMA are hereby adopted as part of this resolution for a period of five (5) years from the date of this resolution.
2. Effective Date. That this resolution shall be effective at the soonest date after its passage and approval, according to law.
