

RESOLUTION N^o 11-87

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF DEWEY-HUMBOLDT, COUNTY OF YAVAPAI, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION(S) FOR FY11 STATE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FUNDS AND FY10 OR FY11 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT STATE SPECIAL PROJECT FUNDS, CERTIFYING THAT SAID APPLICATION(S) MEETS THE COMMUNITY'S PREVIOUSLY IDENTIFIED HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT NEEDS AND THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE STATE CDBG PROGRAM, AND AUTHORIZING ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO IMPLEMENT AND COMPLETE THE ACTIVITIES OUTLINED IN SAID APPLICATION.

Whereas, the Town of Dewey-Humboldt is desirous of undertaking community development activities; and

Whereas, the State of Arizona is administering the Community Development Block Grant Program; and

Whereas, the State CDBG Program requires that CDBG funds requested address one of the three Congressional mandated National Objectives; and

Whereas, the activities within [this/these] application(s) address the community's identified housing and community development needs, including the needs of low and moderate income persons; and

Whereas, an applicant of State CDBG funds is required to comply with the program guidelines and Federal Statutes and regulations.

Now, Therefore, Be it resolved that the Mayor and Common Council of the Town of Dewey-Humboldt, Arizona authorize application to be made to the State of Arizona, Department of Housing for FY11 CDBG funds, and authorize the Mayor to sign application and contract or grant documents for receipt and use of these funds to repair deteriorating roads, provide drainage facilities to alleviate substandard drainage, and construct a separated sidewalk in two service areas with the Wells Addition Right-of-Way as first priority and Placer Addition Right-of-Way as second priority, and authorize the Mayor to take all actions necessary to implement and complete the activities submitted in said application(s); and

THAT this application for State CDBG funds meets the requirements of low- and moderate-income benefit for activities justified as benefiting low- and moderate-income persons, aids in the prevention or elimination of slum and blight or addresses an urgent need which poses a threat to health; and

THAT, the Town of Dewey-Humboldt, Arizona will comply with all State CDBG Program guidelines, Federal Statutes and regulations applicable to the State CDBG Program and the certifications contained in the(these) application(s).
