

RESOLUTION Nº 11-88

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF DEWEY-HUMBOLDT, COUNTY OF YAVAPAI, ARIZONA, FINDING, PURSUANT TO THE REQUIREMENTS OF A.R.S. §36-1473, THAT A REDEVELOPMENT AREA EXISTS IN THE MUNICIPALITY.

Whereas, the State Community Development Block Grant Program Provides assistance for eligible activities which aid in the prevention or elimination of slum or blight; and

Whereas, the State Community Development Block Grant Program requires that an applicant, requesting funds for an activity that will aid in the prevention or elimination of slum or blight, identify a Target Area where such funds will be expended; and

Whereas, the Town of Dewey-Humboldt, Arizona is applying for State Community Development Block Grant funds for an activity that will aid in the prevention or elimination of slum or blight.

Now, Therefore, Be it resolved that the Mayor and Common Council of the Town of Dewey-Humboldt, Arizona finds, pursuant to A.R.S. 36-1473, that the area described as:

Bounded on the north by McCabe Street, and

Bounded on the east by Azurite Street or Old Black Canyon Highway, and

Bounded on the south by Third Street, and

Bounded on the west by Hecla Street, is

the Target Area where State Community Development Block Grant funded activities designed to aid in the prevention and elimination of slum or blight will be carried out; and


THAT, the attached map further identifies the Target Area.


