The plan is to carpool from Dewey-Humboldt to Clarkdale in the morning and then stop by La Fonda (Mexican Restaurant) for a late lunch on the way home.

**11th November (Saturday): Petroglyphs Near Squaw Creek.** This is our next outing to the backcountry. We'll meet at 7:30 AM at the corner of Main & 2nd Street, the site of the Outdoor Museum. We'll be ready to carpool as this trip requires high-clearance vehicles (4-wheel drive always a plus). Our route takes us through the Agua Fria National Monument into Tonto National Forest. This is one of the largest collections of petroglyphs you'll visit up close and personal, but come prepared for a short hike with good, sturdy boots for desert travel as past visits have proven this to be a "prickly cactus" situation. If you're not up for a hike, come along anyhow and bring your camera. The view is great!

Should the weather not cooperate, our alternate outing date will be the very next Saturday, 18th November. A reminder with additional details will follow in early November, but you're gonna want to get this one on your calendar today. We'll also have a spot to meet-up at the entrance of the monument for those of you trailering a UTV.

To all our faithful donors, thanks for making August's blood drive a huge success with 32 donations!





**CHILI-BROWN SUGAR DELICATA SQUASH WITH PEARS**


- 1 pound delicata squash (about 1 large)
- 2 medium ripe but firm pears, sliced
- 2 teaspoons extra-virgin olive oil
- ¼ teaspoon salt
- ¼ teaspoon freshly ground pepper 2 slices bacon
- 2 tablespoons water
- 1 tablespoon light brown sugar
- 1 teaspoon chili powder

Preheat oven to 425°

Cut squash in half lengthwise; scoop out the seeds. Cut crosswise into ¼-inch slices. Toss in a large bowl with pears, oil, salt and pepper. Spread on a large baking sheet.

Roast the squash and pears until just tender, stirring once or twice, 20 to 25 minutes. Meanwhile, cook bacon in a large nonstick skillet over medium heat until crisp, 4 to 6 minutes. Transfer to a paper towel-lined plate.

Discard all but 2 teaspoons fat from the pan. Over medium heat, stir in water, brown sugar and chili powder. Add the squash and pears; toss to coat. Crumble the bacon on top.
