- *Water purifier
- *Can opener
- *Plastic cups
- *Plastic cutlery
- *Paper plates and napkins
- *Aluminum foil/plastic food wrap

If Time Permits, Do Before Departing

- Unlock Gates
- Unlock Doors
- Turn off heater/air conditioner(s)

- Close all exterior doors and windows & remove nearby interior flammables
- Remove portable propane tanks, firewood & other flammables 30+ feet from buildings and other structures' perimeters
- Notify close friends and relatives
- Leave keys in vehicles left behind (so that they can be moved by firefighters)
- Attach hoses to exterior water faucets
- Close interior doors
- Leave 1 or more lights on inside and outside
- Place white towel/sheet at front door (to signify that house has been evacuated)
- Assure that neighbors are aware
- Assist neighbors in need
- If large animals cannot be transported, paint cell phone number on animal(s) and set them free
- If you need assistance, call YCSO at **928-771-3260 As Soon As Possible.**

What to do in advance

- If you have functional needs and may need assistance evacuating, fill in and submit the County's [Function Needs Evacuation Form](#)
- [Firewise your property](#)
- Assure that everyone in the family knows your evacuation destination. Have at least one backup destination
- In case the family is separated, identify a reunion location
- Have all packing material you will need
- Have travel crates for each small animal (dog size and below)
- Have on-hand trailer(s) and vehicle(s) needed to move large animals or know how they will be moved and by whom during an emergency. **Arrange movement at the first sign of danger.**
- Know where large animals and pets can be dropped off
- Sign up and pay attention to alertYAVAPAI , the County's Emergency Alert System - <https://member.everbridge.net/337829242601768/new>
- Know your evacuation zone. Go to <https://protect.genasys.com>

It may be CHAOTIC during an evacuation. LEAVE AS SOON AS POSSIBLE!!!
